GET TO KNOW THE FLU


Adults 65 and older and people with heart and lung disease are at a greater risk³ of flu complications. Conditions include, but are not limited to:

Lung Disease

People with asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease are at a greater risk of being hospitalized with flu complications.

Heart Disease

People with conditions like congestive heart failure may have up to a six-time higher risk of having a heart attack within a week of a confirmed flu infection.



The Flu is Sneaky

It spreads before you have symptoms.

It masks itself from the immune system.

It can start as a tickle in the throat and develop into body aches, fever, cough, sore throat, runny/stuffy nose, headache, and fatigue.

A sick person can spread the flu by sneezing, coughing, even breathing.

The mucus in your nose—where the flu virus typically invades—can protect you from the flu. Mucus is healthiest when you're hydrated, so drink up this flu season.

The flu virus can live 48 hours on hard, nonporous surfaces and 12 hours on soft surfaces. So wash or sanitize all surfaces that come in contact with an infected person.
