He was awarded the Stewardship Award from Shawnee Mission Health and has been honored in Ingram's magazine's 40 Under Forty list of local outstanding professionals. Dr. Sweat was also presented with the Excellence in Teaching Award and the Clinician Educator Award from Mayo Medical School.

Dr. Sweat serves on the boards of the United Way of Greater Kansas City and BioNexus KC. He previously served on the boards of the Kansas City Quality Improvement Consortium and the Don Bosco Center. In 2021, he served as the Co-Chair for Red Hot Night to benefit Children's Mercy Hospital and as the Co-Chair of the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society Light the Night walk.
